



## **Parking Equity**

### **Resolution SR0708-02**

- Whereas,** Associated Students, Inc. is the representative body, and the Official Voice of the Students at California State University, Stanislaus; and
- Whereas,** One of the primary purposes of the Associated Students, Inc. Senate is to advocate for the rights of students at California State University, Stanislaus; and
- Whereas,** California State University, Stanislaus is characterized as a commuter campus with only approximately 7% of students living on campus, making parking services a crucial element of campus infrastructure; and
- Whereas,** Major increases in parking fees at Stanislaus have recently been instituted to collect revenue to allow for the creation of major infrastructure improvements to accommodate the present and future parking needs of the Stanislaus campus community; and
- Whereas,** The California Faculty Association (CFA), during the most recent rounds of compensation negotiations, initially agreed to equity in parking fees among all constituencies and later rescinded their decision after the fact-finding report of the California State University's (CSU) collective bargaining process; and
- Whereas,** As a result of these actions, the majority of new revenue for parking operations at Stanislaus results from parking fees paid by students, who are the least able of all users to underwrite parking for the entire Stanislaus community; and
- Whereas,** The CFA collective bargaining agreement prohibits student-only lots, while allowing faculty and staff-only lots and reserved spots; and
- Resolved,** Associated Students, Inc. of California State University, Stanislaus recognizes that Stanislaus alone cannot mandate the parking policies of our campus due to restrictions imposed by the collective bargaining agreements between CSU and the CFA;
- Resolved,** That the Associated Students, Inc. of California State University, Stanislaus requests that the California State Student Association express their dissatisfaction with the California Faculty Association's actions against student welfare by accepting the fact-finder's findings with regards to parking

as compensation, when this was an issue already resolved in favor of student welfare prior to the fact-finding process; and let it be further

**Resolved,** That the Associated Students, Inc. of California State University, Stanislaus requests that the California State Student Association strongly advocate for a renegotiation of faculty compensation pertaining to parking, so that all parties of the CSU family contribute to the improvements of parking facilities; and let it be further

**Resolved,** That the Associated Students, Inc. of California State University, Stanislaus requests that the California State Student Association strongly advocates for the renegotiation of the collective bargaining agreements in order to allow for the creation of parking restricted to students; and let it be further

**Resolved,** That Associated Students at California State University, Stanislaus distribute this resolution to Chancellor Reed, California State University Board of Trustees, all CSU campus presidents, all CSU ASI Presidents, the California Faculty Association, and the California State Student Association.
