The UWC feels that in order to deliver a quality program no more than 25 students should attend a WP class. Following discussion the UEPC voted to approve the removal of the word “normally” (5 yes, 2 opposed, 1 abstention). Several issues raised during this discussion may necessitate a revision in the charge of the University Writing Committee (6AS92 SEC).
