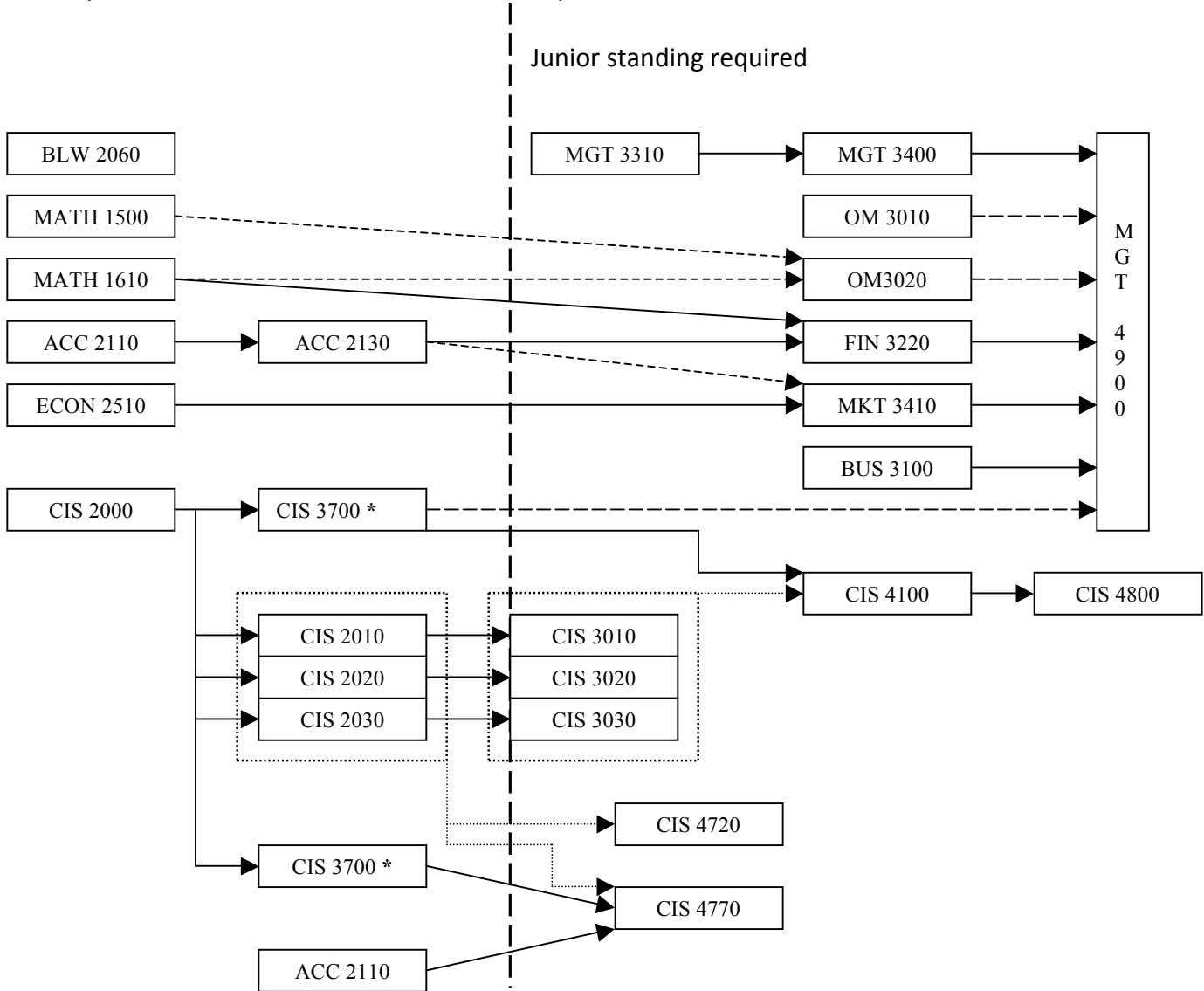
These courses may be taken concurrently with MGT 4900.
