Lower division courses (numbered in the 1000s and 2000s) generally have acceptable equivalents transferable from a junior college. The junior college or the CSUS Office of Enrollment Services should be able to advise you on this. Upper division courses (3000s and 4000s) must be taken at CSUS, or another four-year institution.

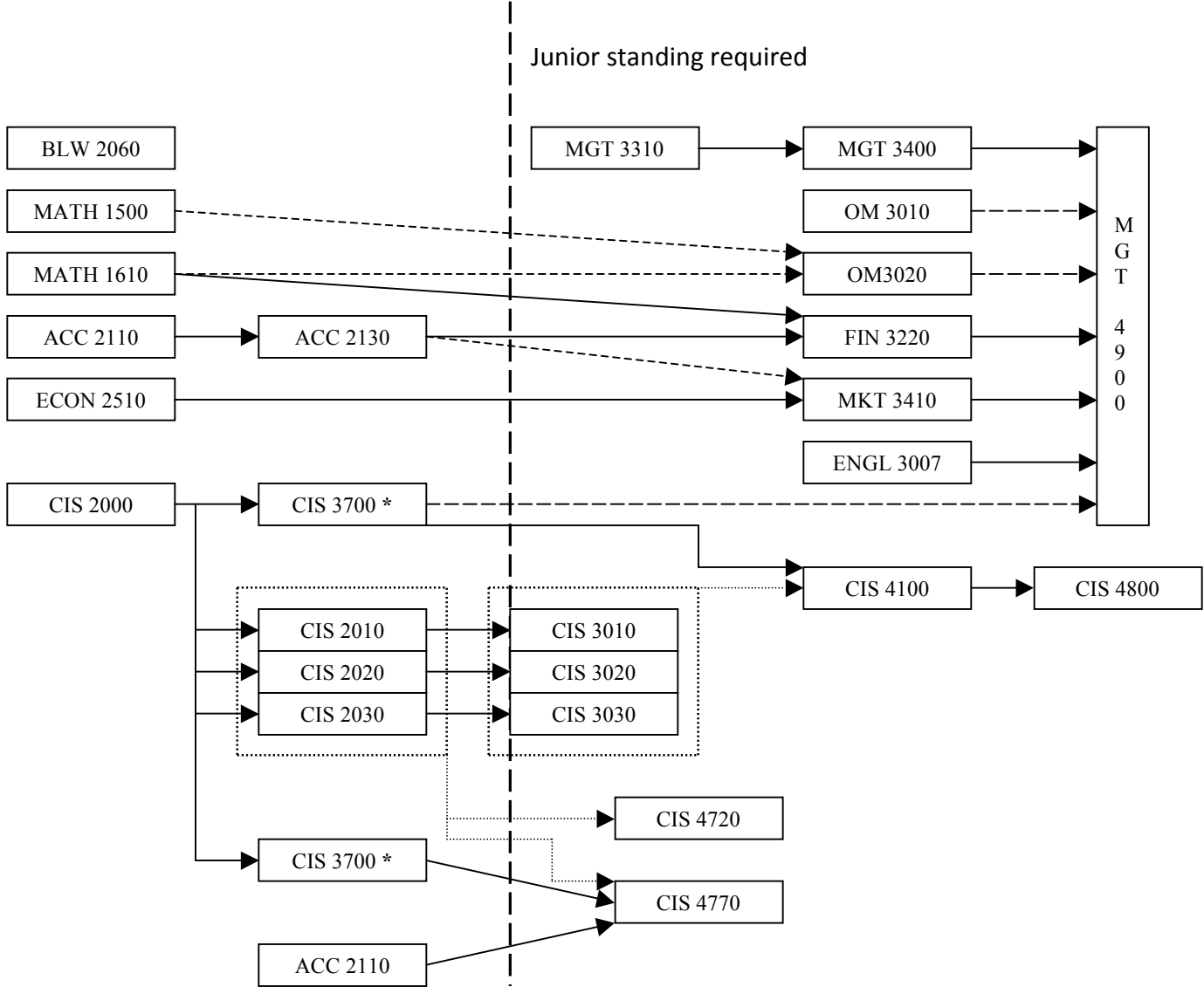
