All letters of application must be received by March 15 of each year.

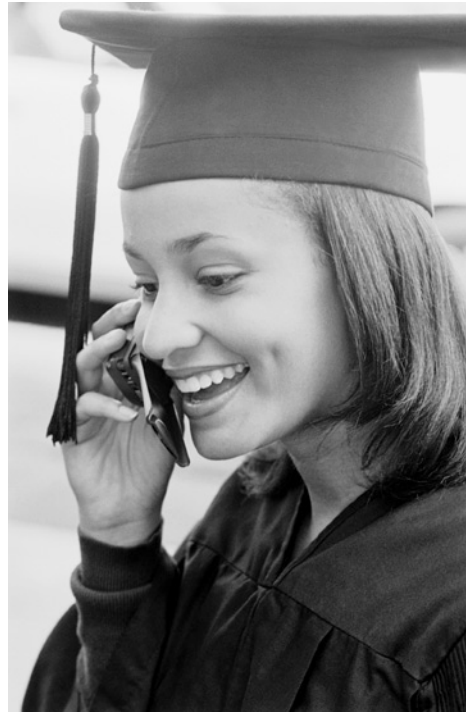
Review of the applications and selection of the award recipients will be completed in March with the actual scholarships awarded annually in April.

John L. Hollis Scholarships

In honor of the memory of John L. Hollis, former Modesto City School Board Trustee, Christian Public Servants annually awards several \$500 scholarships to qualifying students who plan to have a career in public service.

John was a graduate of both Modesto Junior College and CSU Stanislaus, a founding member of CPS, a respected businessman, a loving husband, father, and friend. He was a Christian who unselfishly served his community as a public servant and more.

Qualifications

Applicants for the John L. Hollis Scholarships must be residents of Stanislaus County and be either seniors in high school, recent high school graduates, or college students with a declared intention of preparing for a career in public service (i.e. teaching, law enforcement, fire safety, nursing, public administration, political science, etc.).

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement (a GPA of at least 3.0 is required), participation in church and/or other Christian ministries, **plus** community service.

How to Apply



Prepare a letter of application that includes the following information:

1. Submit a short biography and one page statement explaining why the applicant desires a career in public service and his or her plans to accomplish that goal.
2. Submit the applicant's official transcript. (College students will need to submit their first semester college transcript as well.)
3. Submit two letters of recommendation, one from a church pastor, priest, minister, or youth ministry leader, and one from another non-related adult who has known the applicant personally for some time.
4. Submit evidence of admission to or a signed statement of intent to attend an accredited university or college (unless specified otherwise).
