The submission of this form signifies your request that Housing and Residential Life defer the payment of your housing deposit with the understanding that the deposit will be paid by your 2009-2010 financial aid award. This action is permitted under section 668.165 of the CA Administrative Code as detailed in sections I.I and I.J. of the 2009-2010 Housing License Agreement.

Section I.I. A Licensee may defer payment of license fees if they demonstrate that they will receive federal, state or other financial aid and that such aid will be distributed to the licensee after the beginning of the fee period. Approval of deferment requests shall be subject to verification of pending aid by the University Financial Aid Office.

The deposit will be paid from funds awarded during the first semester of your housing contract. (i.e. Academic Contracts=Fall 2009, Winter/Spring=Winter, Spring=Spring).

The University will deduct first tuition fees, then meal and housing fees from each semester’s financial aid disbursement. If all financial aid for a particular semester has been disbursed and you still have an outstanding housing balance, you must pay the outstanding balance by the end of that semester.
