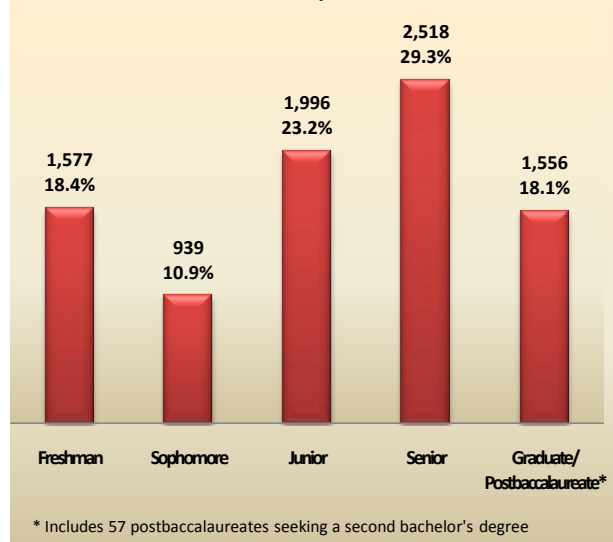
CSU Stanislaus enrolled 8,586 students in Fall 2009. The full-time equivalent student (FTES) figure was 6,607.7.

### Headcount by Study Load

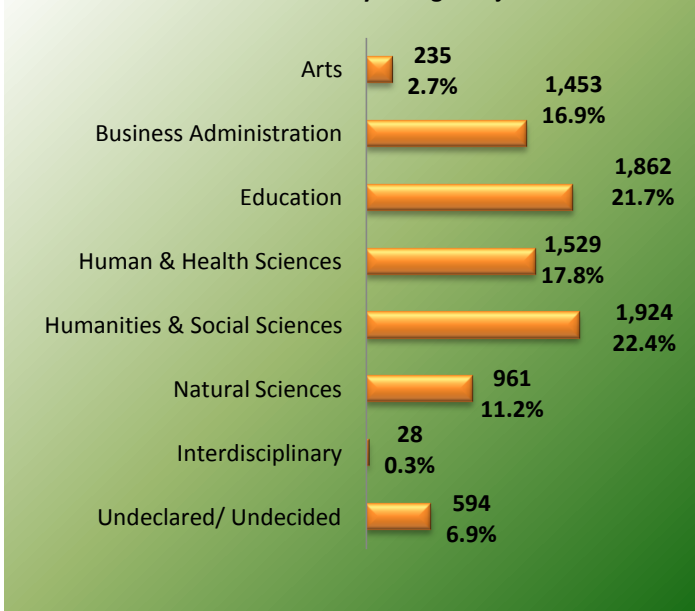

### Headcount by Class Level

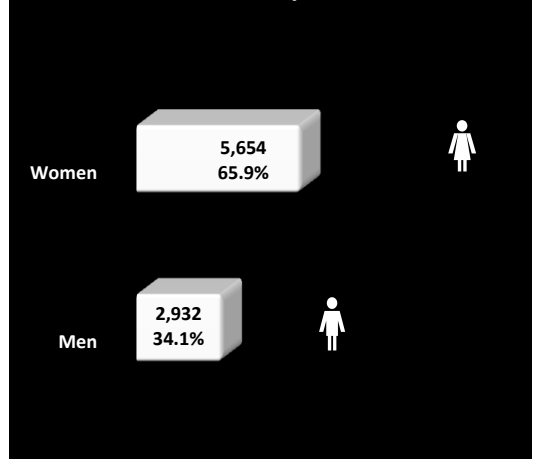


### Headcount by College Major

### Headcount by Gender



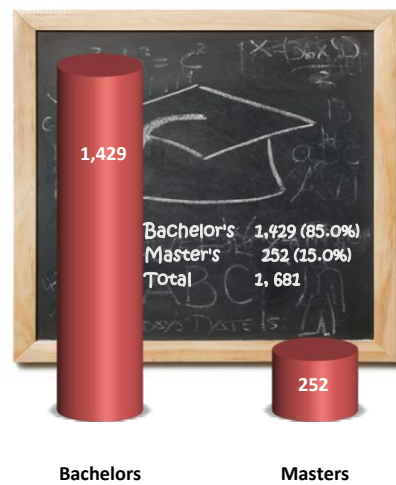

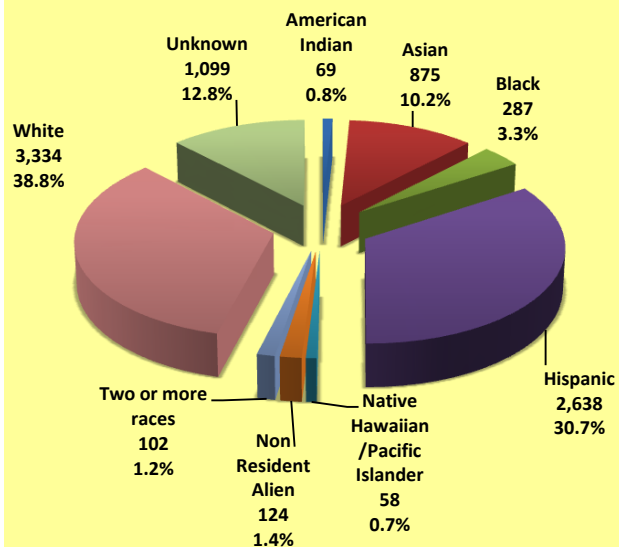
