- _____ Transcripts of Course Work - Submit certified true copies from **each** educational institution attended (secondary school and university, if attended).

- _____ Evaluation of Academic Credentials
All students with university coursework from countries other than the United States are required to obtain and submit to CSU Stanislaus an evaluation of academic credentials. This kind of evaluation will convert educational credentials from any country in the world into their U.S. equivalents, and will help us make a prompt, well-informed decision regarding your admission and/or your transfer credit.

- _____ Verification of English Proficiency
Submit TOEFL score or other verification of English proficiency such as IELTS, SAT, ACT, or completion and transfer of a course that satisfies the CSU General Education Breadth written communication requirement

Include the required documentation that the required funds are available to cover the first year's fees and expenses.

- _____ Health Insurance Promissory Contract Form
Note: The California State University system requires international students purchase Wells Fargo health insurance prior to or during orientation.
