- \_\_\_\_\_ Transcripts of Course Work  
Submit certified true copies from **each** educational institution attended (secondary school and any university transcripts; also submit copy of secondary/high school diploma).
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Verification of English Proficiency  
Submit TOEFL score or other verification of English proficiency such as IELTS, SAT, ACT, or completion and transfer of a course that satisfies the CSU General Education Breadth written communication requirement
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Certification of Finances Form  
Include the required documentation that the required funds are available to cover the first year's fees and expenses.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ Health Insurance Promissory Contract Form  
Note: The California State University system requires international students purchase Wells Fargo Student health insurance prior to or during orientation.
