APPLICATION TO MASTERS IN NURSING PROGRAM

Application Filing Period **March 15 – May 1.**

**You must complete 2 applications for the Graduate Nursing Program.
Applications received after deadline will be considered on space available basis.**

University Admission Information

- **University admission is required prior** to final acceptance to the Masters in Nursing Program.
- Go to www.csumentor.edu for the university admissions deadlines and applications.
- Send 1 set of official transcripts from each previous attended college or university to the **Nursing Department**. In addition, one set of transcripts must be sent to the **Enrollment Services** office.
- For additional information on CSU admission requirements and to apply online, visit the CSU Mentor website.

Nursing Admission Information

- Go to the nursing web site at www.csustan.edu/nursing and download the Masters in Nursing application.
- Send completed application with a copy of your current RN license attached.
- Send 1 set of official transcripts, a résumé with cover letter indicating professional goals, GRE or Miller Analogy scores, statistical data form, and three professional letters of reference.
- Admission to the program is limited to the fall semester. Deadline for application for admission is **May 1.**
- Candidates selected for admission will be notified by the nursing department. The new student orientation will be scheduled the week prior to the start of the program, and selected candidates will be notified as to the date, time, and location of orientation.

Admission Requirements for the M.S. in Nursing

- Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing.
- Minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) in the last 60 units of undergraduate coursework. (Conditional admission is available for GPAs between 2.5 -3.0).
- Current, active California R.N. license
- One year full time nursing experience post initial R.N. licensure, preferred.
- Completion of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) www.gre.org **or** the Millers Analogy.
- Satisfactory completion of an undergraduate statistics course. Must be taken before the second semester of the program with a minimum grade of C.
