#### Nursing Admission Information

- Go to the nursing web site at [www.csustan.edu/nursing](http://www.csustan.edu/nursing) for information.
- Send completed application with a copy of your current RN license, a résumé with cover letter indicating professional goals, Graduate Record (GRE) or Miller Analogy (MAT) scores, statistical data form, and two professional letters of reference.
- The School of Nursing will notify candidates selected for admission.
- A new student orientation will be scheduled the week prior to the start of the first semester.

#### Admission Requirements for the M.S. in Nursing

- Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from an accredited institution.
- Minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) in the last 60 units of undergraduate coursework. (Conditional admission is available for GPAs between 2.5 -3.0).
- Current, active California R.N. license.
- One-year full time nursing experience post initial R.N. licensure, preferred.
- Completion within the past 7 years of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) [www.gre.org](http://www.gre.org) **or** the Millers Analogy <http://www.csustan.edu/testing/>
- Satisfactory completion of an undergraduate statistics course within the past 7 years. Must be taken before the second semester of the program with a minimum grade of C.

#### Admission Requirements for the BRIDGE M.S. in Nursing

- Non-Nursing Bachelor's Degree and an Associate Nurse (ADN) from accredited institutions with a current California R.N. license.
- All requirements listed above and students must pass the **WPST** prior to being admitted, visit <http://www.csustan.edu/testing/> for dates and times.
- Completion of 4 BRIDGE courses (NURS 3300, 3300, 4410, and 3100) prior to progressing into the graduate culminating experience. Availability of BRIDGE courses would correspond with the current RN-BSN roadmap, visit <http://www.csustan.edu/Nursing> for program roadmaps.
