WHEREAS, California State University, Stanislaus will host the 2011 NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships at Al Brenda Track at Warrior Stadium, May 26 through May 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the event is expected to attract more than 1,000 student-athletes from across the nation; and

WHEREAS, segments of the championships will be broadcast on CBS television, bringing national recognition to California State University, Stanislaus and the City of Turlock; and
