CalStateTEACH is a California State University teacher education program for prospective teachers needing to complete a multiple subject credential.

- Field-based instruction
- Available anywhere in the state
- Internet-supported
- No campus-based courses
- Finish in as little as 16 months

HOW does CalStateTEACH REALLY WORK?

- 1 After admission, you attend a one-day seminar at a location near you; there you receive an orientation to the program and directions to getting started.
- 2 Throughout the program you will log on to the CalStateTEACH website to access the study guide, activities, assignments and resources. You will communicate regularly with fellow students and faculty online.
- 3 Completing CalStateTEACH assignments will require at least 12 to 15 hours per week in addition to the time you spend in your classroom.
- 4 You will participate in five additional Saturday seminars during the program on reading, language acquisition, math, science, and the arts and physical education.
- 5 You will work in a K-12 classroom as either a Student Teacher or an Intern.
- 6 At the start of the program, you will receive a box of books and materials.
- 7 Your assigned faculty will visit your classroom at least once a month to observe and assist you. Your on-site mentor is available to help you on a regular basis.

CalStateTEACH ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university
- A grade point average of 2.67 overall or 2.75 in the last 60 semester or 90 quarter units
- Passage of the CBEST (California Basic Education Skills Test) or CSET plus CSET Writing
- Two letters of recommendation
- Evidence of writing proficiency as shown in an autobiographical statement
- An interview with a faculty member
