September 28, 2007

L. Johnson opened the meeting and passed out a copy of our CPR outlines with notations of where things are addressed in the CPR draft. The following items were identified by the group.

CPR Thematic Essay 2, Question 1

- Page 19, paragraph 4, the percentage of the total budget should be shown.
- Page 18, paragraph 1, the Ed.D. is an exception, since it is such a large program the CSU went together and did a system-wide analysis. This is not a matter of course.
- Page 19, paragraph 5, "10-year trend" has an increase of 1.5 which is not a trend. Does not include increase in student assistants.
- Entire section: need benchmark information from Institutional Research. P. Peters and L. Phillips will follow up with K. Silva.
- Entire section is optimistic.

CPR Thematic Essay 2, Question 2

- Entire section: several areas indicate that the TLS subcommittee has oversight which is not in their charge

CPR Thematic Essay 2, Question 3

- Page 22, paragraph 3, "For example, ASI members cited..." doesn't fit as this occurred in a separate meeting. Will need to move that sentence up to the front of the paragraph.
- Page 22, paragraph 4 & 5: need to add evidence pieces as none are indicated.
- Page 24, last sentence: need to clarify which course is the 4 unit course.
- Page 23 paragraph 5: needs to state "a position be created with expertise to handle these types of issues."

CPR Thematic Essay 2, Question 4

- Everything looks representative except increasing student participation in assessment however it is addressed in broad strokes in conclusion 7.

As time was limited and so much as been changed, L. Johnson asked everyone to review it and we will discuss at the next meeting. L. Phillips will email CFR comparison to group, while reviewing identify where CFR's are addressed and bring to the next meeting.
