Counselors' Checklist

Teachers' Checklist

March – May

STAR Testing Window.
EAP English essay window is March 6 – 30

- ✓ Coordinate with your CSU representative junior class presentations prior to testing.

- ✓ Encourage students to take EAP portion of CST and to bubble in authorization to release results to the CSU.

Mid-August

Districts receive EAP results

Students receive EAP status in STAR Student Report

- ✓ Advise conditionally exempt students in math to take an appropriate senior year math experience (SYME).

- ✓ English: Teach a balance of fiction and non-fiction.
- ✓ English: Consider attending an Expository Reading & Writing Course (ERWC) workshop.

September

Conditionally-exempt students should be enrolled in appropriate math course

- ✓ Coordinate group or individual meetings between EAP Recruiter and conditionally exempt and/or non-exempt students, as needed, to explain options.

- ✓ Math: Consider attending professional development workshops offered by the CSU and your county office of education.
