Intent to enroll

The deadline to notify the University of your Intent to Enroll is two weeks after receiving your admissions packet.

If you do not respond by the deadline, your admission will be rescinded and your application withdrawn from the university. You may go to your student self-service web site to declare your intent:

Financial Aid

File your Free Application for Financial Aid at www.FAFSA.gov.

The earliest you can file is January 1, 2011, and the priority deadline is March 2. The school code for CSU Stanislaus is 001157. To complete your application for a Cal Grant, you need to submit your verified grade point average to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). Find out if your school plans to do this for you. If it is not, then obtain the GPA Verification Form from your school, have it completed, and send it to CSAC.

Final Official College Transcripts

Transcripts are required from all previous colleges and universities you have attended, even if you did not complete any coursework.

If we do not receive your final official transcripts by July 15, 2011, your admission will be canceled and you will be disenrolled from classes for the fall 2011 term.
