3. Complete the following documents and return to the ASI office by Wednesday, April 6th, 2011, by 5:00pm.
 - Candidate Application
 - Campaign Personnel List
 - \$25.00 **Deposit for Campaign** (or waiver form if you will NOT be posting or distributing any form of campaign materials)
 - Typed responses to the application questions. Send an electronic copy of the answers to the questions to ASIElectionschair@csustan.edu

Other documents in application packet are included for your information and do not require any action.

4. Review the list of **Important Dates** contained in this packet. Review the Elections Code prior to the mandatory candidates' meeting.
5. You **MUST** attend the mandatory meeting for all candidates. This meeting will take place Friday, April 8th at 11:00am. Campaigning may **NOT** begin until after this meeting. If you have any questions have them ready to be answered at that time, if possible.

Candidate Qualifications
Spring 2010

Undergraduates candidates (All Positions)

- Must have a minimum Fall 2010 GPA of 2.5 (Candidates)
- Must have a minimum fall 2010 GPA of 2.0 (returning BOD members).
- Must be enrolled at least one semester and earned at least 10 semester units during that year.
- Must maintain at least 6 semester units during candidacy.
- Must not have earned more than 150 units.
- Must be in good standing and must NOT be on any kind of probation.

Graduate candidates (All Positions)

- Must earn 6 semester units per term of continuous attendance as a new graduate student.
- Must have a Fall 2010 GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Graduate candidates who receive a bachelor's degree or credential within the past 3 years from CSU, Stanislaus must have earned a minimum of 12 semester units during their last year as an undergraduate to be eligible.
- Must not have earned more than 50 semester units and maintain a minimum of three units while running for office.
- Candidates must be in good standing and must NOT be on probation of any kind.

Academic Board of Directors (Must be a member of the respective college.)

- College of Business
- College of Education
- College of the Arts
- College of Human and Health Sciences
- College of Natural Sciences
- College of Humanities and Social Sciences

Special Interest Board of Directors

Executive Positions

- ASI President and the Vice President: Must have served one semester in the Associated Students, Inc. Senate.
- Executive applicants must be able to provide documentation to be able to work in the United States according to Federal Law.

Important Notes:

- In the event that an Executive candidate does not meet the minimum qualifications of having one semester served on the ASI Board of Directors, the candidate may appeal to the ASI Elections Committee. All appeals must be heard and decided upon seven calendar days before the mandatory candidates meeting.
- Elected students will be expected to adapt work, class and other schedules around the regular Senate meeting time. Senate meetings are held on Tuesday evenings starting at 5:00pm.
- This is NOT a complete listing of all the requirements for running for office. Candidates are responsible for knowing all codes, rules, and deadlines.
