Board of Directors, At-Large

Description of Position: The ASI Board Director At-Large shall lobby for all students at California State University Stanislaus. The ASI Board of Directors At-Large, in compliance with ASI By-laws shall represent students within the Associated Students and the University. Specialized

Qualifications:

- To be a Board Director, At-Large you must be able to represent all students unbiased.
 - Undergraduate candidates for the position must have been enrolled on the campus for one semester prior to the election, earning a total of 10 semester units during that year with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and at least a GPA of 2.5 in the semester immediately prior (either fall or spring) to election or appointment.

Tenure and Terms:

- The ASI Board Director At-Large shall hold office for one year. Such term will begin 12:00 noon on the first day of June and conclude at 12:00 noon on the first day of June the following year.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- The position of ASI Board Director At-Large duties and responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Shall lobby for the rights of all students.
 - Shall maintain a minimum of three set office hours a week.
 - Shall attend an orientation given by the ASI Director.
 - Shall attend summer and winter retreats.
 - Shall review and have knowledge of all the material contained within the ASI Board of Directors Binder.
 - Shall attend scheduled meetings of the ASI Board of Directors held from 5:00 p.m. to adjournment on Tuesdays. (Classes and work shall be planned accordingly).
 - Shall notify the Chair and Rules Committee Chair in advance, of an absence from a scheduled Board of Directors meeting or Standing Committee meeting.
 - Shall review all minutes and attached documents prior to all meetings.
 - Shall keep up with current student issues.
 - Shall meet with the VP of Student Affairs and the Dean of Students monthly, or as needed.
 - Shall serve on at least one of the following Standing Committees (each senator will have the choice of which committee they want to join): Rules Committee, Elections Committee or Budget Committee.
 - Shall serve on a minimum of three campus-wide committees (membership decided by the Vice President, Internal and approved by the President).
 - Shall have the power to bring forth a nomination for any unfulfilled senate seat in the event that a position is unfilled for 30 days.

- Shall serve on the Open Forum/Campus Dialogue Committee (Faculty Affairs, Residential Life and ASI).
- Shall be actively involved in ASI programs and events.
- Shall have all powers and duties as outlined in the ASI Constitution.
- Shall be subject to the Point System as outlined in Section 5.0 of the ASI By-Laws.
