

**Associated Students, Inc.

President and Chair

Description of Position: The ASI President and Chair, in compliance with ASI By-laws, shall represent students within the Associated Students and the University.

Qualifications:

➤ Candidates:

- Undergraduate candidates for the position must have been enrolled on the campus for one year-prior to the election, earning a total of 12 semester units during that year with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Undergraduate candidates must maintain 6 semester units while running for office and not be on academic or disciplinary probation of any kind.
- Graduate candidates for the position must earn 6 units per semester of continuous attendance as a new graduate student. Graduate and post baccalaureate candidates must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Graduate candidates who have received a bachelor degree or credential during the previous three years must have earned 12 units during their last undergraduate term.
- Graduate candidates must maintain 3 units while running for office and not be on academic or disciplinary probation of any kind.

➤ Incumbents:

- Undergraduates must earn 6 units of credit and earn a minimum of 2.0 or higher per semester while holding office and not be on academic or disciplinary probation of any kind.
- Undergraduates students must not exceed 150 semester units. If units exceed 150, the student will no longer be eligible for ASI Board of Directors.
- Graduate and post baccalaureate incumbents must earn a minimum 3 semester units of academic credit with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and not be on academic or disciplinary probation of any kind.
- Graduate students must not exceed 50 semester units. If units exceed 50, the student will no longer be eligible for ASI Board of Directors.
- Graduate candidates must not be on probation (academic or disciplinary) of any kind.

Specialized Qualifications:

- To be President you must have served one semester as a member of the ASI Board of Directors. In the event that a candidate does not meet the minimum qualification of having one semester served on ASI Board of Directors, the candidate may appeal to the

ASI Elections Committee. All appeals will result in an interview with the Elections Committee and be decided upon seven calendar days before the mandatory candidates meeting. The Elections Committee will take the following into account during the interview:

- Knowledge of Associated Student, Inc,
- Knowledge of current event in regards to higher education,
- Political System and Administration at CSU Stanislaus,
- Political Systems in the CSU System,
- Campus current events.

The ASI Elections Committee may waive the one semester requirement.

Tenure and Terms:

- The ASI President shall hold office for one year. Such term will begin 12:00 noon on the first day of June and conclude at 12:00 noon on the first day of June the following year.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- The position of ASI President and Chair duties and responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Shall maintain a minimum of 15-20 office hours a week, 10 hours of which must be posted.
 - Shall Chair ASI Board of Director Meetings.
 - Shall be familiar with Parliamentary Procedures as defined in Robert's Rules of Order.
 - Shall meet with members of ASI for Parliamentary Procedure training.
 - Shall lobby for student rights to University and statewide entities on behalf of the Associated Students, Inc. of CSU Stanislaus.
 - Shall serve as a member on all committees and organizations of the Association, or shall designate representatives to serve in that capacity.
 - Shall maintain oversight for Budget Analyst, Governmental Relations Representative and University Affairs Representative.
 - Shall meet with the University President as needed.
 - Shall meet with the Vice President of Student Affairs monthly or as needed.
 - Shall attend summer and winter retreat.
 - Shall attend scheduled meeting of the ASI Board of Directors held from 5:00 p.m. to adjournment on Tuesdays. (Classes and work shall be planned accordingly).
 - Shall create and post all meeting agendas and minutes in compliance with Gloria Romero.
 - Shall review all minutes and attached documents prior to all meetings. .
 - Shall serve on a minimum of five campus-wide committees.
 - Shall be actively involved in ASI programs and events.
 - Shall have all powers and duties as outlined in the ASI Bylaws.

- Shall be subject to the Point System as outlined in Section 5.0 of the ASI By-Laws.
