



University Student Union Board of Directors

General Information

1. The University Student Union is a not-for-profit corporation funded primarily by student fees, and consists of three parts: facilities, programs, and services. The facilities include the Student Union building here on campus and a Student Union Lounge at the Stockton campus. Programs include activities organized by the University Student Union Program Board (USUPB) as well as special events held throughout the year. The services include the sale of postage stamps, photocopies, bus passes, balloons, movie tickets and many other conveniences offered at the Information Desk and Game Room.
2. The role of the University Student Union Board of Directors is to make decisions concerning policy, renovations, marketing, and budgetary items, while providing overall direction for the facilities, programs, and services funded by Student Union fees.
3. The University Student Union Board of Directors has fifteen voting members:
 - 9 student representatives
 - 1 faculty representative
 - 1 alumni representative
 - 1 designee of the University President
 - 1 designee of the Vice President for Business & Finance
 - 1 outside community representative
 - 1 Associated Students Inc. (ASI) representative
4. All student seats on the Board of Directors become vacant each year. Students currently serving on the Board of Directors must submit an application in order to be considered for another term.
5. The term of office for members of the University Student Union Board of Directors will begin on June 1 and will end on May 31.

6. The Board of Directors meets twice monthly during the Fall and Spring semesters. Board members are expected to attend all meetings, serve on at least two Board committees, and participate in planning retreats (typically held in August and January). Board members also participate in regional conferences.
