Programming:

Warrior Squad, and Warrior Fanatics, are student volunteer programs of the Associated Students Inc. (ASI). The Program Board and Eco Warriors are a student volunteer program through the University Student Union (USU). These are annually run programs, which start at the beginning of each fall semester. These programs work as collective teams to ensure that campus life & Warrior pride is always in abundance on campus.

ASI Warrior Squad:

The ASI Warrior Squad works with the ASI Board of Directors, Staff, & Warrior Fanatics to promote student involvement and campus life.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Programming and getting other students involved
- Planning and Coordinating campus special events such as StanFest, Welcome Week, Homecoming, and Warrior Day
- Distribution of ASI giveaways, and/or flyers

ASI Warrior Fanatics:

The ASI Warrior Fanatics works with the ASI Board of Directors, Staff, Warrior Squad & campus athletics to promote school spirit and encourage CSUS student participation on and off campus.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Increase campus spirit and involvement by promoting upcoming events
- Providing extracurricular activities such as: Booster Bus Travels, Tailgates, Fight Song Competition & Half Time Entertainment
- Offer reward programs for students such as: Trade Back Program, "Got caught being a Warrior," Wear Warrior Red, Fight Song Competition, Warrior Fanatic T-shirts and game giveaways

USU Eco Warriors

The USU Eco Warriors works with the USU Board of Directors, Staff, Warrior Squad & Warrior Fanatics to promote campus and Warrior sustainability in environmental, social, and economic areas.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Plan and coordinate campus events such as: Sustainability Week, Campus pledge to recycle, Greeks Going Green, Take Back the Tap, Electronic Disposable Day, Ditch the Car Day, Trash n' Fashion, party recycle bins, Trash It With Titus, Spring Clean, etc.
- Educate students about sustainability initiatives on environmental management and human consumption.
- Offer reward programs for students such as: "Do it in the Dark T-Shirts, reusable warrior drink glasses, other USU giveaways, and/or flyers
- Join National Organizations for Sustainability Issues such as: California Collegiate Recycling Council, Association for Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education, Campus Compact, Association of American Colleges and Universities, and the American Association of State Colleges and Universities.

University Student Union Program Board

The USUPB works with the USU Board of Directors and Staff to promote the University Student Union Building by providing daily activities, weekend trips, and diversity, social, and cultural awareness.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Planning and coordinating campus events such as: Lecture Series, Feed the Students, Warriors in the Quad, Weekend Trips and a variety cultural Heritage Days.
- Promotion of USU events
- Distribution of USU giveaways, and/or flyers.

Requirements for all Programmers:

- Enrolled and in good standing; maintaining a 2.0 GPA (undergraduate) or 3.0 (graduate) and 6 units per semester at CSU Stanislaus.
- Volunteer a minimum of 3 hours per week.
- Must attend weekly meetings: ASI Warrior Squad: Mondays 4:00-5:30, USUPB: Tuesdays 4:00-5:30, ASI Warrior Fanatics: Wednesdays 4:00-5:30, USU Eco Warriors: Thursday 4:00-5:30
