Invest in You!!! - Tips for College Success

It's never too early to start thinking about your Credit Score!!!!

Understanding how credit works is important for managing your finances. It includes everything from the types of loans and credits you may be offered the interest rates you might get if you decide to purchase a car.

Credit scoring is a system creditors use to help determine whether to give you credit. Information about you and your credit experiences, such as your bill paying history, the number and type of accounts you have, late payments, collection actions, outstanding debt and the age of your accounts is collected from your credit application and your credit report.

Using a statistical program, creditors compare this information to the credit performance of consumers with similar profiles. A credit scoring system awards points for each factor that helps predict who is most likely to repay a debt. A total number of points—a credit score—helps predict how credit worthy you are; that is, how likely it is that you will repay a loan and make the payments when due.
