**CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, STANISLAUS** is seeking a creative, experienced, and visionary leader to serve as Dean of the College of Human and Health Sciences. As chief academic and administrative officer of the College, the Dean reports to the Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs and serves as a member of the President's Executive Cabinet. The Dean provides the academic and administrative leadership required to achieve the highest standards of excellence in teaching, research, scholarship, and service within the College. The successful candidate must be a scholar, innovator, fundraiser, and a person who enjoys connecting with a diverse campus and external community.

**THE UNIVERSITY:** California State University, Stanislaus serves one of the fastest growing areas in the country: the San Joaquin Valley. Widely recognized for its quality academic programs, the University has 10 nationally accredited programs and approximately 400 full-time faculty. The University offers 40 undergraduate majors, 23 master's programs, and seven post-graduate credentials serving 8,836 students. New instruction facilities have been built for the unique pedagogy of professional programs, laboratory sciences, and performing arts.

The College of Human and Health Sciences offers bachelor's degrees in child development, nursing, and psychology and master's degrees in child development, nursing, psychology and social work. The candidate is expected to have extensive experience in an academic leadership position at the department level or above, preferably dean.
