CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, STANISLAUS is seeking a highly experienced, energetic, results-oriented academic leader to serve as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. As the chief academic officer, the Provost reports to the President, serves as the senior officer in the President's absence, and serves as a member of the President's Executive Cabinet. The Provost is involved with all aspects of the University in the coordination and implementation of academic goals, educational policy, curricular planning and development, academic program quality and assessment, faculty personnel actions (including recruitment, retention, promotion, and tenure), sponsored research, academic budgets, library services, extended education, international education, athletics, institutional research, accreditation, enrollment management, and academic master planning.

The Provost represents the University administration in the affairs of the Academic Senate and is responsible for promoting a collegial atmosphere, encouraging shared governance in developing academic policy, and maintaining a student-centered focus. The Provost performs cross-functional and university-wide duties to accomplish the strategic goals and mission of the University, including active promotion of student retention and assessment of institutional effectiveness. The Provost works with faculty representatives within the context of a statewide collective bargaining agreement.

THE UNIVERSITY: California State University, Stanislaus serves the San Joaquin Valley, one of the fastest growing areas in the country. Widely recognized for its quality academic programs, the University has 10 nationally accredited programs and approximately 400 full-time faculty. The University offers 40 undergraduate majors, 23 master's programs, and seven post-graduate credentials serving 8,836 students. New instructional facilities have been built for the unique pedagogy of professional programs, laboratory sciences, and performing arts.

CSU Stanislaus was recognized by the American Association of State Colleges and Universities as one of 12 public universities nationwide that demonstrate exceptional performance in retention and graduation rates. U.S. News and World Report ranked CSU Stanislaus as one of "The Top Public Universities- Master's" institutions in the West in its America's Best Colleges ratings. The University is recognized as a Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) by the U.S. Department of Education, and CSU Stanislaus has received national recognition with its ranking as one of the best 366 colleges in the nation by The Princeton Review.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must possess an earned doctorate from an accredited institution, an extensive record of senior-level administrative experience, and a portfolio of accomplishments in academic advancement. Experience in working within a collective bargaining environment is preferred. A proven record of distinguished teaching, research, and scholarship commensurate with a faculty appointment at the rank of a tenured professor is required.
