**Pre-licensure Program Admission Information**

**Prerequisites – Pre-Nursing Major**

At least four (4) of the prerequisites courses must be completed at the time of application to the program, two of which must be science courses. Remaining prerequisite courses may be in progress at the time of the nursing application, and one course may be taken in the summer prior to Fall entry. Students must successfully complete all prerequisites with a minimum of grade of C.

### Fall Entry Application Deadline Dates

University Application - Priority application to the university is from Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> to Nov.30<sup>th</sup>.

Supplemental Nursing Application - Application filing period for nursing is Jan. 24<sup>th</sup> to Feb. 28<sup>th</sup>.

### Spring Entry Application Deadline Dates

University Application -Priority application to the university is from Aug. 1<sup>st</sup> to Aug. 31<sup>st</sup>.

Supplemental Nursing Application - Application filing period for nursing is Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> to Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>.

University Application - Students need to be admitted to the University in order to apply to the nursing program.

Supplemental Nursing Application - All applicants must submit a complete supplemental Pre-licensure Nursing Program application packet to the Nursing Department. Program admission is contingent upon meeting minimum requirements (see below) and passing a physical exam, drug screening and a background check.

### Minimum Requirements

- Overall GPA of 3.0
- Science prerequisite GPA of 2.75
- Other non-science prerequisite GPA of 2.75
- Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course
- No more than 2 prerequisite courses may be repeated
- No prerequisite course may be taken more than twice
- At least 4 of the prerequisite courses must be completed at the time of application
- At least 2 science prerequisite courses must be completed at the time of application
- Minimum test score (Adjusted Individual Total Score) of 75% on the ATI TEAS test
