Licensed Psychiatric Technicians are qualified to practice in a variety of health care settings and provide patient care within the parameters of the Psychiatric Technician scope of practice. A San Joaquin Delta College Certificate of Achievement is awarded upon successful completion of the program. An Associate of Science in Psychiatric Technician is awarded upon successful completion of other general education courses that satisfies the college degree.
