Requirements for Application to the RADT program:

1. ALLH 67, BIOL 16, CHEM 2A, ENGL 1A, MATH C, and RADT 50. All prerequisites and program requirements must be passed with a grade of "C" or better, and their combined GPA must be 2.75 or higher.
2. Program requirements must be satisfied prior to submitting an application to the program.
3. An official transcript listing all program prerequisites must accompany an application before the application will be officially accepted. Applications are accepted all-year round.

Students will be selected from a waiting list which will be established based on the following criteria:

1. Completion of all program prerequisites with a grade of "C" or better in each of the above courses with a combined minimum GPA of 2.75
2. Submit a complete application packet with transcripts verifying all prerequisites listed above have been met

Upon verification by the Allied Health Division, your name will be placed on the waiting list according to the date and time application is submitted.
