Requirements for Application to the RADT program:

- 1. ALLH 67, BIOL 16, CHEM Aa, ENGL 1A, MATH C, and RADT 50. All prerequisites and program requirements must be passed with a grade of "C" or better, and their combined GPA must be 2.75 or higher.
- 2. Program requirements must be satisfied prior to submitting an application to the program.
- 3. An official transcript listing all program prerequisites must accompany an application before the application will be officially accepted. Applications are accepted all-year round.

Students will be selected from a waiting list which will be established based on the following criteria:
