Graduate Research Strategies Workshop

This workshop is designed for all majors and stages in the research process. The first part of the session includes a presentation on key research strategies for graduate students and demonstrations of research resources identified as useful to workshop participants. The second part of the session will be a hands-on workshop in which students can explore tools in their disciplines and develop their research strategies. The librarian instructor will answer individual questions related to the students' specific research projects. Style manuals, such as APA, MLA, and Chicago, and citation formatting can also be discussed.

Thesis/Project/Dissertation Formatting Workshop

This workshop will focus on the University's preparation guidelines for a master's thesis or project and the doctoral dissertation. A review of the organization of the thesis/dissertation will be presented and sample layouts examined from the online thesis/dissertation template. Such issues as typesetting the thesis/dissertation, formatting tips, and problem areas will be discussed, as well as the process for submitting the thesis/dissertation for binding (or electronic repository). Information for "who in the Library to contact about what" with regard to your thesis/dissertation will also be provided.
