 - Make sure your name is on the top of the document.
2. If currently admitted to CSU, Stanislaus provide your Stan ID number and complete the Pre-Admission Checklist. You will not need to apply to the university or to the program. If admitted to the program, more information will be sent to you.
3. If *NOT* currently admitted to CSU, Stanislaus please obtain an electronic or scanned copy of your at transcripts (*unofficial acceptable for this step*) for any college or university attended. Official transcripts will be required for admission to the University (see #5).
4. Email the Pre-Admission Checklist and, if applicable, your transcripts to mperearyan@csustan.edu
