Engineering Technician

Full-Time, \$14.59 – \$15.82 (DOE)

The East Stanislaus Resource Conservation District (ESRCD), a special district dedicated to resource concerns in and around East Stanislaus County, has an opening for a full-time Engineering Technician to provide assistance working on resource conservation projects that the District and/or its partners undertake under contract with various agencies, organizations and individuals. This position is temporary and is dependent on available funding.

The ideal candidate will have an agricultural background and experience with, or knowledge of:

- Math Skills: water quantity computation and unit conversions
- Basic GIS
- Quantity computations (measuring units of flow rate, volume & velocity)
- Drafting/CAD: skills or willingness to learn
- Measuring unit conversions
- Irrigation systems with pumping stations
- Data collection and evaluation in spreadsheets
- Project planning and coordination

Engineering Technicians must be willing to assist with field work inspections and work professionally and courteously as representatives of ESRCD and NRCS while interacting with private landowners and local, state and federal entities and personnel. Qualified candidates must be able to communicate clearly and effectively, both written and verbally, with customers and staff.

This position will also assist as a Resource Conservation Technician as projects and deadlines necessitate.

Basic computer skills, including proficiency with Microsoft Excel, are required. Must be able to complete a heavy work-load within deadlines.

A degree is not required for this position, but related course work is preferred. This position may allow for flexibility around college class schedules for enrolled students.

Candidates must possess, or be able to obtain, a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. A background check is required upon employment.

This position is full-time, as funding allows.
