Applying to Graduate School

Two-Step Application

1. University Application

- Fall application period begins October 1st.
- Spring application period (if open) begins August 1st.
- Submit the online university graduate application through www.csumentor.edu.
- \$55 non-refundable application fee (must be paid in order to process)

2. Program Application

- Visit the department website and follow instructions. (Program application periods and deadlines vary by program.)
- Include any required documents (personal statement, letters of recommendations, exam scores, etc.) These differ by program.

Admissions Process

1. Transcripts

- Submit one official transcript from EACH institution you have attended or are attending, including those from junior college(s) attended.
- * *CSU Stanislaus Alumni*, who have not attended elsewhere since graduation, do not need to submit new transcripts.

2. Decision

- The department will notify you of your acceptance.
- Admission to the university is contingent upon receiving admission to the program.
