Scope of Review

This assessment reviewed the effectiveness of the Housing and Residential Life program, management and support staff.

Mission

Assessment Summary

II. *Identified strengths and weaknesses.*

Strengths:

- The highest rated sections were Assessment and Evaluation, Campus and Community Relations, Legal Responsibilities, and Equal Opportunity, Access, and Affirmative Action.

Weaknesses:

- The components with the lowest ratings were the sections on Mission and Program. In reviewing these sections it appears that rewriting the Mission Statement and an expansion of educational programming will address these issues.

Priorities for the Program

- Rewriting our Mission Statement to reflect the Mission of the university.
- Identifying desired outcomes.
- Establishing means of improving evaluation of the food plan.
