

PTO #16 No person shall, without lawful authority, deface, injure, attach any material or substance to, knock down, or remove any traffic control device, traffic guidepost, or traffic post erected or maintained by the university.

PTO #17 VEHICLE REPAIR: Private vehicle repairs may not be performed on campus without advance approval the University Police, and shall be for emergency repairs only.

PTO #18 USE OF LOST/STOLEN DECALS: No person shall use a parking decal that has been reported as lost or stolen

PTO #19 No person shall ride a skateboard, roller blades or roller skates within prohibited, posted areas of the California State University, Stanislaus.

BLUE LIGHT PHONES

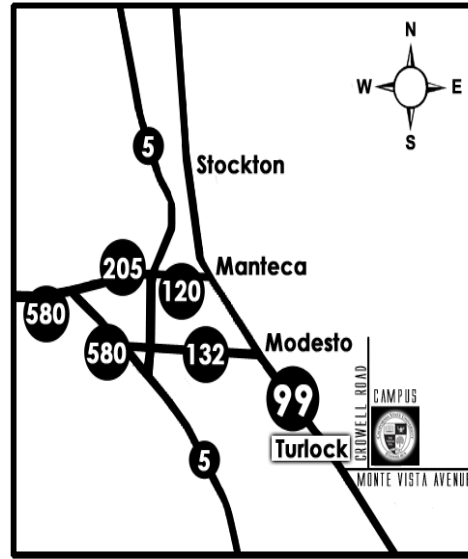

ENFORCEMENT

Parking decals must be displayed by 7:00 AM on the fourth academic day of each semester.

Permit and meter parking regulations are strictly enforced 7:00 AM - 10:00 PM Monday through Friday, including all academic holidays.

The only grace period is the first three days of each semester. This does not include meters.

Handicapped and reserved parking is enforced at all times.

Authority, pursuant to state codes, all traffic and parking is subject to regulations and fees, compliance to these regulations is mandatory (sections 42200 & 42201, title V, California Code of Regulations, and 21113 California Vehicle Code).

Responsibility for enforcement of these special regulations and the applicable sections of the California Vehicle Code is assigned to University Police Department.

Permits may not be used in lieu of payment of a parking meter fee unless displayed with a handicapped placard or plate.

The purchase of a parking permit **does not guarantee** a parking space on campus.

TYPES OF PERMITS

Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer term permits are available for Faculty, Staff, and Student parking.

Annual Permits are available for Faculty and Staff and expire on June 30 of each year.

Daily permits are available from various dispensers. Permits are **not valid in Faculty/Staff parking areas until after 4:00 PM.**

Handicapped parking placards authorizing exceptions for disabled individuals parking on campus are issued through the California State Department of Motor Vehicles. Persons utilizing handicapped placards **must purchase and display a valid California State University, Stanislaus parking permit while parking on campus.**

**Reserved parking is enforced: M-F 7:30am-5:00pm
Special permit is required**

DISPLAY OF PERMITS

Repositional decals must be displayed on the inside, lower corner, driver side windshield. If you drive more than one vehicle you may transfer this decal between vehicles.

Visitor, and daily dash passes must be displayed on the left side of the dash board, and are not valid in meter, or reserved areas.

Motorcycle permits are valid only in motorcycle areas, and are available at a reduced price.

PARKING & TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

PTO #1 All vehicles parked on the California State University, Stanislaus campus are required to display a valid California State University, Stanislaus parking permit or a valid temporary permit, except those vehicles parked in metered or loading zones.

PTO #2 No person shall attempt to evade payment of parking fees by the use of a forged or fictitious parking permit.

PTO #3 Parking permits must be displayed in the manner and in the location prescribed.

PTO #4 No person shall violate the University Manual Regulations concerning the use/or display of parking permits.

PTO #5 Vehicles must be parked in the areas valid for the parking permit they display.

PTO #6 No vehicle may be left in a **metered space** unless there is **unexpired time** showing on that meter.

PTO #7 **Vehicles shall not park in the following areas:**

- A. Any area of the campus which is not posted or improved and marked for parking.
- B. Any area assigned for handicapped parking unless that vehicle displays a valid California State University, Stanislaus parking permit and distinctive license plates or placard issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
- C. Any area marked for loading/unloading,

unless that vehicle is immediately engaged in loading/unloading within the posted limitations.

PTO #8 All vehicles shall park in a designated space, between the white lines, and shall be facing forward.

PTO #9 No person shall disobey the lawful orders of a member of the University Police relating to the parking and/or movement of vehicles on campus.

PTO #10 Vehicles parked in reserved parking spaces must display a reserved parking permit during hours of enforcement.

PTO #11 Motor vehicle travel is restricted to the roadways and parking areas of the campus. Individuals requiring the use of sidewalks for vehicular movement shall obtain advance permission from the University Police.

PTO #12 Vehicles shall not be left parked overnight without permission of the University Police, with the exception of vehicles of dorm residents.

PTO #13 No person shall abandon a vehicle on campus. Vehicles parked continuously for 72 hours or more will be presumed abandoned and will be towed to a public garage for storage.

PTO #14 Persons operating bicycles on campus shall obey the following rules:

- A. Bicycle travel is restricted to the roadways, parking areas, sidewalks and pathways.
- B. Bicycles will be operated in a safe manner, having due regard for persons and property.
- C. Bicycles will be parked in provided bike racks and shall not be chained to any stationary objects, with the exception of bike racks. Bicycles parked in violation of this section may be impounded the University Police.
- D. Bicycles will be equipped as required by the vehicle code and shall display a valid bicycle license.
- E. Bicycles are not allowed in campus buildings at any time.
- F. Bicycles are restricted to 10 MPH on all sidewalks and pathways.

PTO #15 It shall be unlawful for any driver of a vehicle to fail to obey any sign or signal erected or maintained by the university to regulate the flow of traffic.
