- (4) Identify and describe the components (e.g., classroom management, instruction, and assessment) of an effective classroom.
- (5) Share your understanding of current state and federal accountability initiatives as they pertain to student achievement.
- (6) Identify and describe a mechanism or structure to raise student achievement at a school.

A 4-point rubric was designed for each Essential Question. The rubrics used to score the exams range from 4 = Exemplary to 1 = Below Standards. *Mean scores are reported*.
