

The Stanislaus Futures Health Scholarship is a strategic, need-based scholarship designed to support CSU Stanislaus students in the pursuit of a bachelor's degree in health careers

To be considered for the Stanislaus Futures Health Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Must graduate from a Stanislaus County high school
- Complete the FAFSA and demonstrate financial need as determined by federal guidelines
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Plan to enroll full-time at CSU Stanislaus pursuing a bachelor's degree in a health-related field (nursing, biology, health science)
- Complete an online application at: stanislauscf.org/scholarships



How much money can I get?

The scholarship is \$2,000 per academic year. Recipients can renew scholarship up to 4 years if they demonstrate persistence towards a health degree.
