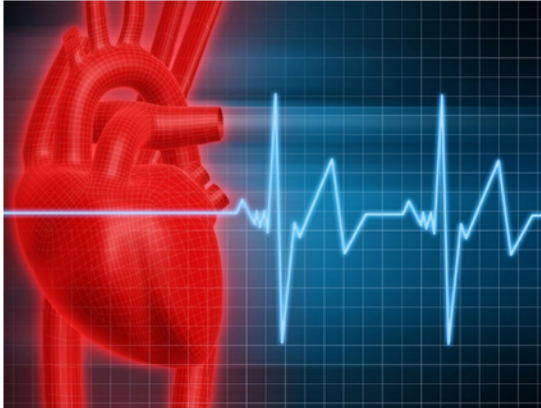

Requirement for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

The California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) requires that all students applying for an initial Credential demonstrate that they have “infant, child, and adult CPR certification which meets the criteria of the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross.”

Students who already have CPR certification need to provide a copy of the document, via email, fax or in person, to Credential Services in DBH 303.
