#### **SERSCA Mini Grants**

### **Program Guidelines & Requirements**

#### Overview

SERSCA Mini-Grants promote student engagement in research, scholarship, and creative activity by funding project needs, including equipment, materials, and supplies. Mini-Grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until all awards have been allocated.

# Benefits

SERSCA anticipates awarding up to forty (40) Mini-Grants of up to \$500 each available during the 2021-22 academic year.

# Eligibility

- Open to Undergraduate, Graduate, and Post baccalaureate students currently enrolled at Stanislaus State.
- All applicants must be nominated by a faculty sponsor. An individual faculty member may sponsor up to **three** applications per year.
- Students may apply for one SERSCA Mini-Grant per academic year.
- Applications must come from a single student; no sharing of awards is allowed.
- Funds must be awarded by May 31, 2022.
- A final report is required. Eligibility for future SERSCA funding is contingent upon report submission by June 1, 2022.

### **Application Instructions**

Students are responsible for the completion of the application form. The Faculty Sponsor listed on the application will be responsible for approving the submission for SERSCA review.

The Mini-Grant application includes:

- Project Description
- Student Statement
- Description of Student Contributions
- Budget

### COVID-19 and Budget Considerations

Applicants may include personal protective equipment (PPE) and cleaning/disinfecting products in the project budget. This may be appropriate for students conducting field work or those students with approval to conduct RSCA on campus.
