Step 1. Select your Organization Affiliation	Type into the search box "California State University, Stanislaus" Agree to terms of service and affirm affiliation.

Step 3. Create your Username and Password	Choose a username, create a password and provide a security question and answer
Step 4. Demographic Information	Complete your demographic information
Step 5. Continuing Education Unit (CEU) credit for completed CITI Courses	Most will choose "no." CITI offers CE credits and units for purchase for qualifying courses.
