- 3 units that satisfy the Global and US Ethnic Contexts requirement
 - o 13 courses from which to choose see back of this document
- 12 units in one Concentration History, Society and Inequality (HSI); Culture, Ideology and Representation (CIR); or Ethnicity, Nationality, and Sexuality (ENS) see back of this document for a list of courses in each concentration.
- Electives within Gender Studies (or approved courses from other disciplines) to achieve 30 units (including 24 upper division)

Courses may satisfy more than one requirement, but a total of 30 units is required for the degree, with at least 24 at the upper division (3000 or 4000) level. Cross-listed courses may be taken under either the GEND or cross-discipline section.

Students choosing to complete a double-major can cross-count up to 49% of courses in both majors upon approval by the major advisor in each program.
