

The Hybrid Program Accelerated Schedule

- 2 courses every 8 weeks
- 2 face-to-face class sessions per course
- One Saturday per month @ CSU Stan Stockton Ctr.
- Remainder of course work completed online (asynchronous & synchronous)
- Direct social work practice courses are included in every 8 week academic session

The Hybrid Program Summer Block

- Enhance competency-based skills in direct clinical practice
- 40 hours per week x 13 weeks (500 hours per summer)
- Located in home county when possible
- Employer-based placements if available
- One-to-one supervision from MSW Field Instructor
- 2 hours per week seminar in a local community
- 2 all day Saturday Integrative seminars at CSU Stockton


University Application

Students admitted to the two year MSW Program who quality are eligible to apply.


Eligibility for 3 Year Title IV-E Stipend Program





Instructions: Three academic and/or professional references are required. Provide this form—Link to Master of Social Work Reference Form—to your references and ask they complete the form AND a letter. Please make sure you give clear instructions to your references to upload the form AND letter together with a deadline giving you enough time to submit your application by the deadline of 11:59 pm on February 1. No exception will be allowed.

*Note: Reference letters must be typed, with current date and signed.




