- A. The AA-T for Elementary Teacher Education is now the recommended pathway for students wishing to transfer to the Liberal Studies Major at Stanislaus State. Courses in the AA-T as well as additional courses listed above from Columbia, Merced, Modesto, and Delta Colleges fulfill the Subject Matter Waiver requirement for the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) observing the following:
 - a. Choosing from options satisfying the standard GE requirements can satisfy most of the Liberal Studies subject requirements. The Liberal Studies Department website provides the appropriate CSUS course selection and a Sample Road Map that combines CCTC requirements with the GE. All courses, excluding labs and unless otherwise noted, require a minimum of 3 semester units or approval of the Liberal Studies Department Chair.
 - b. Lower-division courses do not fulfill the upper-division major requirements.
 - c. The California Commission on Teacher Credentialing requires Liberal Studies Majors complete each of the Subject Matter Preparation Program Requirements with a grade of C- or better.
 - d. The courses that satisfy the CCTC requirement in Early U.S. History and American Government will differ from those community college courses certified for completion of the CSU's US History/Constitution/American Ideals requirement. See the community college catalogs for approved courses.
- B. Liberal Studies majors should take the Writing Proficiency Screening Test (WPST) as soon as they pass a course that satisfies the G.E. Area A.3 Critical Thinking requirement, with a grade of C- or better. WPST passage is required before enrolling in LIBS 3000 Community and Diversity (WP).
