

# "SAMPLE" Road Map for COLUMBIA Transfers to CSU Stanislaus, Liberal Studies Major

The following is **ONE ALTERNATIVE** for COLUMBIA students to complete the LIBS major and GE requirements (for additional alternatives, see an advisor on your campus). **Transfer** students should take LIBS 3000 (WP) in their first term at CSU Stanislaus and **NOT** take additional lower division coursework in completed GE areas until meeting with a LIBS advisor for alternative patterns. **COLUMBIA courses are RED** and **CSU Stanislaus classes are BLUE**.
