

# Road Map for SJ DELTA Transfers to CSU Stanislaus Stockton Campus, Liberal Studies Major

The following road map is for DELTA students to complete the LIBS major and GE requirements at San Joaquin Delta College AND CSU Stanislaus, Stockton Campus. If offered, **Transfer** students should take LIBS 3200 (WP) in their first term at CSU Stanislaus to remain on track for graduation. **DELTA courses are RED** (refer to the *LIBS Subject Matter Course Articulation chart for other course choices*), and **CSU Stanislaus courses are BLUE**.
