Roadmap Advising Form B.A. in Sociology Effective Fall 2006

Requirements: There are six different concentrations that students can select including: #1 General Major, #2 Human Services, #3 Drug and Alcohol Studies, #4 Social Deviance and Criminology, #5 Social Inequalities, and #6 The Body, Culture, and Society. There are 20 units in the core and 16 to 18 units in the concentrations, depending on classes taken totaling 36-38 units. Degree minors in Sociology and Gerontology are also offered.

- 1. Complete University General Education requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree (51 units minimum).
- 2. Complete University requirement of 120 units for the Bachelor of Art degree.
- 3. Complete the following prerequisites to the major: (3 units)

- 4. Complete the major of not less than 36 upper-division units, as approved by the major advisor. Majors must take all courses counted toward the major for a letter grade if the letter grade option is available.
- 5. Students must achieve a C average or above in to count toward fulfilling the requirements for the major.
- 6. Students must achieve an overall average GPA of 2.0 or better in all university coursework...
- 7. Completion of a minor is not required. However, the university rule for units in the minor is: half the units in minor, plus one, must be used solely for the minor. This means that half the units, minus one unit, can count somewhere else in either General Education or in the major.
