

Two paths to become a Registered Nurse *and* earn your Bachelor of Science in Nursing

PREPARE IN HIGH SCHOOL

- college preparatory track for CSU admission four years of English, Algebra, Geometry, Algebra II, Biology, Advanced Biology, Chemistry
- college credit verified by AP examination
- concurrent enrollment in college classes





BSN PRE-LICENSURE PATH

Apply and attend CSU Stanislaus

- attend an information session
- take prerequisites to nursing program

Apply to CSU Stanislaus Pre-licensure BSN Program

 upon admission to program, complete nursing courses and all general education

GRADUATE WITH A BSN

- obtain license to practice as an RN
- obtain California Public Health Nurse Certificate

RN TO BSN PATH

Apply for dual admission

- at the community college of your choice and CSU Stanislaus
- during last year of high school or first term at community college (Delta, MJC or Merced)
- seek information from community college counselors

Complete nursing prerequisites at a community college or CSU Stanislaus

• take appropriate prerequisites for the nursing program(s) you plan to apply to.

Apply to an Associate Degree Nursing Program

- complete nursing program
- obtain license to practice as an RN

Apply and enroll at CSU Stanislaus Nursing Program

- complete lower and upper division GE
- complete nursing coursework

• obtain California Public Health Nurse Certificate
