

## Dr. Sourik Banerjee

Sourik joined the Department of Economics as an Assistant Professor of Macroeconomics in Fall 2022. His primary research interests are in the areas of Financial Economics, Open Economy Macroeconomics and Financial Crises. His recent work has focused on the determination of interest rates in overlapping generation (OG) economies, and the reasons why countries prematurely exit International Monetary Fund (IMF) – supported programs. In CSU Stanislaus, he teaches Principles of Macroeconomics, Economics of Investment and Money and Banking courses primarily. Prior to joining California State University, Stanislaus, Sourik was a Lecturer of Economics at the Albers School of Business and Economics in Seattle University. He received his Ph.D. in Economics from University of Nevada, Reno in 2021. He also has Master of Science and Bachelor of Science degrees in Economics from University of Calcutta in India.
