The *Mathematics and Science Teacher Initiative (MSTI) Program* will award annual scholarships in the amount of **\$2,000** for eligible students who intend to teach Math, Science, or any STEM related field in Secondary Education (Middle/High school). Mathematics, Science, and STEM majors who have completed at least one semester at Stanislaus State by Spring 2023 and STEM career professionals who have been admitted into the Single Subject Credential Program for Spring 2023 are eligible to apply. A minimum <u>2.75 GPA</u> is required.

Scholarship recipients and eligible applicants who maintain a minimum <u>2.75 GPA</u> (or higher) <u>MUST</u> apply on a yearly basis for the *Mathematics and Science Teacher Initiative* (MSTI) scholarship. Juniors, Seniors, and Credential students are eligible to apply at this time.
