

The Stanislaus Health Careers Scholarship is a strategic, need-based scholarship designed to support CSU Stanislaus students in the pursuit of a Bachelor's degree in health-related fields.

20 to 30 scholarships are given out annually.

To be considered for the Stanislaus Health Careers Scholarships, you must meet the following criteria:

- Must graduate from a Stanislaus County high school
   <u>OR</u> be a current CSU Stanislaus student pursuing a
   health-career degree
  - Includes students in the Nursing Sequential
    Enrollment Program in partnership with Modesto
    Junior College
- Complete the FAFSA and demonstrate financial need based on Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
- Complete an online application at stanislauscf.org/scholarships

## How much money can students receive?

The scholarship amount is \$2,000 per academic year. Recipients can renew up to 4 years if they demonstrate persistence towards a degree in a health-related field.
