| Amador Family Scholarship Fund | \$1,000 per award | 3 (one of each) | AZEVEDO: Current/former female students of Modesto High pursuing an education in the field of medicine; demonstrates financial need; BAVA: Current/former Modesto City School District students; LUBECK: Current/former female students of Modesto High pursuing an education in the field of business or computer science; demonstrates financial need. |
| Bee Scholarship - McClatchy Family | Up to \$3,500 | 2 to 3 | Child/grandchild of current or past Modesto Bee employee with 5+ years of continuous employment (if FORMER employee, they must have left in good standing); must be attending an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. |
| Delta Kappa Gamma Educator Scholarship | \$2,000 Renewable | 2 | Applicants must be college students currently enrolled in a teaching credential program, current student teachers, current teacher interns, students enrolled in a speech therapy program, or students enrolled in a school psychology program. Colleges considered: CSU Stanislaus, U.C. Merced, U.O.P., UMass Global (Formally known as Brandman University), Teachers College of San Joaquin. Students must be in good academic standing, with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0. Be enrolled full-time in their program. |
| Dr. Grant E. & Colleen Bare Scholarship | typically \$3,500 per student | 2 or 3 | Graduate of Stanislaus County HS, enrolled at MJC w/plans to attend a 4-year university in coming school year, pursuing education in health sciences or mathematics or science. |
| Dr. Larry Cooke Memorial Scholarship | \$500 | 1 | Attending Notre Dame or other Catholic university, resident of San Joaquin Valley (CA), B average or above, pursuing education in the field of medicine. |
| Earl Pride Scholarship | \$1,000 | varies | County Employees & their children/step-children; employee must work 24+ hours per week on a regular basis. |
| Gemperle Family Farms Scholarship | \$1000-\$3000 Renewable | 3 to 6 (depending on number of renewals) | Child/grandchild of current Gemperle Farms employee (or employee themselves) with 3+ years of continuous employment; must be attending accredited 2 or 4 year college or university. Scholarship is renewable up to four years. |
| Maralyn J. Stewart Memorial Scholarship Fund | \$1,000-\$2,500 | varies | Available to Modesto City Schools high school seniors or graduates of Modesto City Schools who demonstrate financial need and participated in performing arts while in high school. |
| Martella Family Scholarship Fund | \$500-\$1,000 Renewable | varies | Child or grandchild of current employee of Martella Farms or Grower Direct with 3+ continuous years of employment in good standing; 2.5+ GPA; accredited 2 or 4 year university. |
| Richard & Dolla Squires Memorial Music Scholarship | \$1,000 | 1 | 1) Personal - Current Music student pursuing music degree in College (Major in Music). 2) Area of Study - Music. 3) Institution - any Junior College or 4 Year College. 4) Other - must have recommendation by Teacher. |
| Stanislaus Health Career Scholarship | \$2,000 Renewable | 10-20 | Open to current graduating Stanislaus County high school seniors planning to pursue a health-career degree from CSU Stanislaus, and to current CSU Stanislaus students pursuing a health-career degree, including students in the Nursing Sequential Enrollment Program in partnership with Modesto Junior College. Must demonstrate financial need. |
